What Can KSU Tribal TAB Do For You?

KSU Tribal Technical Assistance to Brownfields (TAB) is free and tailored to the specific needs of a Tribe or Tribal community and is usually coordinated through the tribal environmental director or 128(a) Tribal Response Program (TRP) - brownfields project manager.

Brownfields Workshops, Webinars, Self-Paced Courses

KSU Tribal TAB organizes and assists with a variety of brownfields workshops in EPA Regions to include Alaska. Workshops address a wide range of brownfields issues. Workshops can be tailored to tribal and community needs.

EPA 128(a) TRP Grants and TRP Coordinator Support	Training, mentoring and support for the 4 Program Elements, Public Record, Institutional Controls and assistance with grant work plans
Brownfield Inventory and Site Assessments	Identification of Brownfield Sites, community meetings, prioritization of sites, Phase I & II assessment processes, QAPPs, TBAs, etc.
Brownfield Site Cleanups	Planning for redevelopment or reuse of brownfield sites, contracting, QAPPs, community meetings, cleanup options and cleanup oversight, enforcement and certification.
EPA 104(k) Assessment and Cleanup Grants	Visioning and community meetings to explore reuse of sites, redevelopment of sites, coordination with other programs and funding sources, review of draft 104(k) grant proposals (TABEZ Program)

Brownfields Technical Assistance Available to Tribal Organizations

Technical Assistance to Brownfields (TAB) is a national program funded by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). TAB helps guide tribal governments through the brownfields inventory, assessment, cleanup and redevelopment process, using custom-tailored teams of experts to address site-specific needs and provide mentoring.

Examples of TAB Service:

- Technical presentations, workshops and seminars
- Strategic planning and redevelopment visioning workshops
- Economic feasibility and sustainability analysis
- Identification of potential funding sources
- Assistance with environmental justice issues
- Guidance in finding and contracting with environmental firms
- Independent review and summary of technical documents
- Community outreach
- Liaison service between you, state or federal agencies, or other entities
