 - o Demonstration of Previous RLF Grant Status (see Section III.B.2.)
 - o Description of RLF Boundaries (see Section III.B.3.)
 - o Description of cleanup oversight (see Section III.B.4.a.)
 - o Legal opinion establishing that the applicant has authority to
 - (1) access and secure sites in the event of an emergency or default of a loan agreement or non-performance under a subgrant; and
